<u>Question</u>: If someone sends a message, "I give her a single divorce," and then forwards it to his wife and other couple of people. Are those considered to be different Talaaqs?"

In the name of Allah, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful

Answer:

Assalamu Alaikum wa Ramatullahi wa Barakaatuhu.

Granted that the message in consideration was as simple as presented in the query and that there are no further relevant details to consider, our advice will be that <u>No</u>, your message will **not** be considered as multiple Talaaqs, it will be considered as ONLY ONE Talaaq.

This is due to the fact that your sole intention was just one Talaaq, the recurring forwarded messages will be considered as just reminders of that one Talaaq due to it <u>being one statement</u> <u>and not multiple separate statements.¹</u>

The message will only be considered as one Talaaq if it reaches your wife directly from yourself or a proxy delivered it with *your permission*.²

May Allah grant us the correct understanding of his Deen.
