With regards to the iktilaaf with ahlus zawaahir that 3 talaaqs in one majlis is one, does it refer to 3 separate talaaqs as well such as talaaq talaaq or only u have been issued 3 talaaqs / anti taaligun thalaathin?

Answer:

As for the Zaahir Riwaayaat, it is mentioned in Badaai' us Sanaai' that if the root word "Talaaqun" is used with the intention of 3 Talaaq then the 3 Talaaq occurs even though the word was said once. If the intention was only one Talaaq then only one occurs, due to the Masdar or root word having the ability to contain the maximum of limit of the possible meanings of a word when intended.

If the words Talaaq Talaaq Talaaq are used in one majlis, then according to Zaahir Riwaayaat only one occurs because when Masdar is used in a general sense without specifying an intention then the minimum possible meaning is used due to Masdar being singular.¹

If the specific intention is given with a specific number such as you have been issued 3 Talaaq then there is no ikhtilaaf that the 3 Talaaq have occurred because the place or majlis is not important in the ikhtilaaf but rather the words and niyaat.²
