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## **Question**

Asalamualikum I want dua for my daughter marriage Someone said that she got black magic but I didn't believe fully Can you please guide me

بِسْمِ اللهِ الرَّحْمنِ الرَّحِيْم

## In the name of Allah, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful

## Answer:

We will mention a dua that will definitely fulfil all Halaal needs (insha Allah) as long as our conviction is correct and our trust is placed in Allah, but first we must clarify the issue of suspected black magic.

There is no specific dua that will show if a person is affected by black magic or not, however the signs of black magic may become apparent at times or an experienced Raaqi may also be able to tell.

Some possible symptoms of black magic or evil eye include dullness of the eyes and constant loss of focus, headaches which move from place to place, constant evil dreams, sudden mood swings, unusual heaviness of the shoulders or entire body, forgetfulness, or fear. <sup>1</sup>These are only a few symptoms and these signs do not definitely indicate black magic but may even indicate medical problems, thus the need for diagnosis by a Raaqi.

If a woman is having problems finding a spouse, this does not necessarily mean that she is affected by black magic but the issue may be otherwise. (*For more information you may contact the Ruqya department of Darul Ilm Birmingham*.)

The best means of finding the best spouse for your daughter is to firstly give Sadaq and offer two Rakaats of Salaat ul Haajaat daily.<sup>2</sup> This will definitely work if we place full trust in the power of Salaat and if it is performed in the way of the Sunnat. The following is the dua that is prescribed after Salaat ul Haajaat :

لا إلَهَ إلا اللهَ الْحَلِيمُ الْكَرِيمُ سُبُحَانَ اللهِ رَبِّ الْعَرْشِ الْعَظِيمِ

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ رَبِّ الْعَالَمِينِ أَسْأَلْكَ مُوجِبَاتِ رَحْمَتِكَ وَ عَزَائِمَ مَغْفِرَتِكَ وَالْغَنِيمَةَ مِنْ كُلِّ بِرِّ وَالسَّلَامَةَ مِنْ كُلّ إِثْمِ لا تَدَعْ لِي ذَنْبًا إلا غَفَرْتَهُ وَلا هَمًا إلا فَرَّجْتَهُ وَلا حَاجَةً هِيَ لَكَ رِضًا إلا قَضَيَّتُهَا يَا أَرْحَمَ الرَّاحِمِينَ

There there no god but Allah the Clement and Wise.

There is no god but Allah the High and Mighty.

Glory be to Allah, Lord of the Tremendous Throne.

All praise is to Allah, Lord of the worlds.

I ask you (O Allah) everything that leads to your mercy, and your tremendous forgiveness, enrichment in all good, and freedom from all sin.

Do not leave a sin of mine (O Allah), except that you forgive it, nor any concern except that you create for it an opening, nor any need in which there is your good pleasure except that you fulfill it, O Most Merciful!"

The method of Salaat ul Haajaat is the same as any other two Rakaats of Nafil Salaat and may be performed at any of the permitted Salaat times of the day. Then the above dua is recited afterwards with full focus and humility while begging Allah to fulfil your needs.
